

ORDINANCE NO. 674

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF MURRAY, NEBRASKA, TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASED SEWER RATE FOR THE USE OF THE VILLAGE OF MURRAY'S SEWAGE SYSTEM FOR ALL CLASSES OF CUSTOMERS, AS CODIFIED IN VILLAGE OF MURRAY, NEBRASKA CODE OF ORDINANCES, TITLE 52 "SEWERS", SECTION 52.15 "RATE SETTING"; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT; TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM; AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**Section 1.** The Village of Murray Board of Trustees has acknowledged notification of service rate increase by the vendor for the processing of sewage by Beaver Lake Association effective January 1, 2023, for the following classes:

Residential Rate Increase	.30 cents from	\$27.91 to \$28.21
Business Rate Increase	.50 cents from	\$34.85 to \$35.35
School Rate Increase	\$5.00 from	\$219.18 to \$224.18

**Section 2.** The Village of Murray Board of Trustees has determined that it is necessary to increase sewer rate charges to its residential, commercial and school properties in order to meet current operating and maintenance expenses, and to satisfy debt and provide for meaningful capital improvements. Therefore, the Village Board of Trustees has determined that the following sewer rates will become effective January 28, 2023:

Residential Rate Increase	.30 cents from	\$67.58 to \$67.88
Business Rate Increase	.50 cents from	\$75.26 to \$75.76
School Rate Increase	\$5.00 from	\$260.76 to \$265.76

**Section 3.** All other ordinances or resolutions approved prior to the passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance which conflict with these provisions are repealed.

**Section 4.** This ordinance is adopted and published in pamphlet form and shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.
