

RESOLUTION 24-03

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title IX, Chapter 93, Section 93.06 of the Murray, Nebraska Code of Ordinances, the Governing Body shall be Resolution sell excess personal property to the highest bidder:

WHEREAS, the Governing Body requests sealed bids distinctly marked on the outside "Village of Murray, Excess Equipment, May 9, 2024" and it shall bear the name and address of the bidder in the upper left hand corner;

WHEREAS, bids will be accepted at Village Hall located at 106 W Main Street or mailed to the Village Clerk, PO Box 79, Murray NE 68409 no later than 4:30 pm on May 9, 2024. Bids to purchase shall not be to purchase fewer than the number of items listed for sale;

WHEREAS, the bidder will be required to pay by cash, cashier check, or money order. Personal checks will not be accepted. The bidder must remove the items purchased at their expense within five (5) days of notification. All items are sold as is with no warranty;

WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds that the fair market value is less than \$5,000; and

WHEREAS, formalities may be waived and the Village reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairperson and Board of Trustees of the Village of Murray, Nebraska hereby declare as surplus property the following:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the clerk post in the three public places as provided in Resolution 24-03 a Notice of Sale of Excess Property for not less than seven days [Ref 17-503.01].
